STREET ANGELS – WHAT IS IT?



- A visible presence in the community
- Provide care and practical support to people in need.
- Help people access support.
- Listen to people who are in distress or at risk of physical harm.
- Work with and alongside, but not in place of, police and local service providers.

STREET ANGELS – WHAT DO THEY DO?



- -Teams of 2 or 3 would walk agreed areas in Belper's estates between 8pm and 12pm every Friday night.
- -Our focus would be the needs of young people in particular.
- -Our presence would seek to reassure residents who have a negative impression of young people.
- -We would be able to respond to one off events, eg. Halloween, a youth funeral, etc.

STREET ANGELS – WHAT WOULD IT LOOK LIKE IN BELPER?





It is not: 'befriending' although we seek to build community relationships.

It is not: 'proselytising' although we very much hope to demonstrate the love of God.

It is not: 'the police' although we work alongside them to help create community cohesion

STREET ANGLES PROJECT TEAM.



£3000 to launch.

Equates to 10 people giving £25 per month.

STREET ANGELS FINANCE.



We need a minimum of 16 volunteers to launch.

Volunteers who:

- Are 18 or over.
- Can commit to 1 night per month for a year.
- Are willing and available to be trained.
- Agree to an enhanced CRB check (FOC).
- Are in good standing with their community.
- Are comfortable relating to young people and the diversity of issues they face.
- Are in support of Christian values and the aims of Street Angels.
